

RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE AMENDMENT OF THE "1953 ORDINANCE GOVERNING ENROLLMENT IN THE CROW TRIBE OF INDIANS OF MONTANA"

WHEREAS, The Crow Tribal Council amended resolution no. 76-06 at its July , 1975 quarterly Council Meeting to require one-quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) Crow Indian blood for enrollment purposes,

AND WHEREAS, a good deal of confusion has arisen over the exact effect of the above-described amendment,

AND WHEREAS, The Crow Tribal Council wishes to eliminate any such confusion,


AND WHEREAS, The Crow Tribe is firmly committed to maintaining the integrity of its Tribal Rolls.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Section 1 (C) of the "1953" Ordinance governing enrollment in the Crow Tribe of Indians of Montana" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The membership of the Crow Tribe shall consist of:

- (c) All children of $\frac{1}{4}$ th or more degree of Crow Indian blood born to any member of the Crow Tribe and who follow the enrollment procedures as hereinafter set forth.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED this 10th day of July 1976 by Unanimous votes for and No votes against.
